


What to Look for:

- Ensure that Reading lessons are completed first. Reading lessons supply almost all Reading Plus data and are the highest priority.
- Celebrate success! For example, congratulate your child on every Reading lesson completed with 80% or higher comprehension.
- ✓ Look for Combos. Your child will earn a Combo when he or she completes two Reading lessons in a row at 80% or higher comprehension. Combos will help your child to move up a Reading level, so celebrate them!
- Remind students about ReReads. When answering questions in Reading lessons, students can look back at what they read to ReRead it. This helps them pick the right answer. Check to make sure your child is using ReReads.
- Ensure assignments are done by the end of the weekend. For most schools, assignments reset every Sunday night at midnight.





